# Arrests

There were a total of **147** reported arrests made in June of 2011. This is a **14%** decrease from the **171** reported in May.

In comparing 2010 & 2011, there were **970** reported arrests made in the mid way point of 2011. This is **6%** more than what was made in the mid way point of 2010 which recorded **915** arrests.

## **Arrests per month**

In the Mid way point of 2011, the monthly arrests average was **162** (161.66) arrests per month. In the same time frame from a year earlier, the average was **153** (152.5) arrests per month.

# Traffic Citations

There were **160** reported traffic citations issued in June of 2011. This is a **41%** decrease from the **269** reported in May & **48%** less than in June of 2010 which saw **306** citations issued.

In 2011, traffic citations issued decreased by **20%** from mid way point of 2010.

## **Traffic Citations per month**

In the Mid way point of 2011, the Iberia Parish Sheriff's Office issued an average of **218** (218.16) citations per month. In the same time frame from a year earlier, the average was **271** citations issued per month for traffic violations.

# Vehicle Crashes

There were **33** reported vehicle crashes in June of 2011. This is a **7%** increase from the **31** reported in May & **35%** fewer than what was recorded in June of 2010 which saw **51** vehicle crashes reported.

In 2011, reported vehicle crashes increased by **27%** from mid way point of 2010.

## Vehicle Crashes per month

In the Mid way point of 2011, there was an average of **71** (71.33) reported vehicle crashes per month. In 2010, reported vehicle crashes averaged **56** (56.16) per month.

# Residential Burglaries

There were **44** residential burglaries reported in June of 2011. This is an **8%** decrease from the **48** reported in May & a **52%** increase from what was recorded in June of 2010 which saw **29** residential burglaries reported.

In 2011, reported residential burglaries increased by **61%** from mid way point of 2010.

## **Residential Burglaries per month**

In the Mid way point of 2011, there was an average of **42** residential burglaries reported per month. In 2010, reported residential burglaries averaged **26** (26.16) per month.

## **Total Residential Burglaries by district**

In comparing the mid way point of 2011 & 2010, all of the Districts, with exception to **District 4**, saw increased calls for residential burglaries. The greatest increases were in **Districts 1 & 3** who both had **93%** more calls for residential burglaries by the mid way point of 2011 than they saw by the mid way point of 2010.

The only decrease in residential burglaries was in **District 4** which had **42%** fewer reported in 2011 than what was recorded in 2010.

## **Monthly Residential Burglaries by District**

The average for residential burglaries reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was approximately **5** (4.83) per month. In the same time in 2010, it was approximately **3** (2.5) per month.

The average for residential burglaries reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was **13** per month. In the same time in 2010, it was approximately **8** (7.5) per month.

The average for residential burglaries reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was **9** per month. In the same time in 2010, it was approximately **5** (4.66) per month.

# Business Burglaries

There was **1** business burglaries reported in June of 2011. This is an **88%** decrease from the **8** reported in May & an **89%** decrease from what was recorded in June of 2010 which saw **9** business burglaries reported.

In comparing the 2011/2010 totals, business burglaries decreased by **30%**.

## **Business Burglaries per month**

In the Mid way point of 2011, there was an average of **5 (4.66)** business burglaries reported per month. In 2010, reported business burglaries averaged **7 (6.66)** per month.

## **Total Business Burglaries by district**

In comparing the mid way point of 2011 & 2010, the only **District 4** recorded an increase in crimes of this type.

Every other district recorded a decrease in business burglaries with exception to **Districts 3** who recorded no change.

## **Monthly Business Burglaries by District**

The average for business burglaries reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was less than **1 (0.5)** per month. In the same time in 2010, it was approximately **1 (0.83)** per month.

# Vehicle Burglaries

There were **37** vehicle burglaries reported in June of 2011. This is a **19%** increase from the **31** reported in May & a **16%** increase from what was recorded in June of 2010 which saw **32** vehicle burglaries reported.

In comparing the 2011/2010 totals, vehicle burglaries increased by **2%**.

## **Vehicle Burglaries Per Month**

In the Mid way point of 2011, there was an average of **23** (23.16) vehicle burglaries reported per month. In 2010, reported vehicle burglaries averaged **23** (22.83) per month.

## **Total Vehicle Burglaries by district**

In comparing the mid way point of 2011 & 2010, increases of **30%** & **76%** can be located in **Districts 1 & 5**.

All of the other districts recorded slight decreases in these types of crimes in comparing the mid way point of 2011 & 2010.

## **Monthly Vehicle Burglaries by District**

The average for vehicle burglaries reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was approximately **6** (5.83) per month. In the same time in 2010, it was approximately **5** (4.5) per month.

The average for vehicle burglaries reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was **2** per month. In the same time in 2010, it was approximately **2** (2.33) per month.

# Robberies

There were **6** robberies reported in June of 2011. This is 1 fewer than what was reported in May & a **50%** decrease from what was recorded in June of 2010 which saw **12** robberies reported.

In comparing the 2011/2010 totals, robberies decreased by **18%**.

## **Robberies Per Month**

In the Mid way point of 2011, there was an average of **6** robberies reported per month. In 2010, reported robberies averaged **7 (7.33)** per month.

## **Total Robberies by District**

In comparing the mid way point of 2011 & 2010, the only district to record an increase is **District 1**.

The greatest decreases in the number of robbery calls was located in **Districts 4 & 5** which recorded **50% & 42%** fewer crimes of this type .

## **Monthly Robberies by District**

The average for robberies reported monthly in the mid way point of 2011 was less than **1 (0.66)** per month. In the same time in 2010, it was less than **1 (0.33)** per month.
